

TYLER COUNTY POLICY: FE

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

The Tyler County Board of Education supports the concept of equal educational opportunity and its application to facilities. The Board shall ensure that all students will receive fair and equitable treatment in use of school facilities.

Generally, all school facilities must be available without discrimination on the basis of gender, race, national origin, language, disability, marital status, parenthood, or pregnancy. However, locker rooms, restrooms, and showers must be separate but comparable. Facilities such as gymnasiums, track, and other athletic fields must provide for its use by males and females on a non-discriminatory, equitable basis, including prime time.
