

TYLER COUNTY POLICY: GAN

BEGINNING PRINCIPAL INTERNSHIP

Every person hired for the first time in Tyler County Schools as a principal or assistant principal shall complete a one school year internship. It shall include an orientation program to be conducted prior to or during the instructional term, depending upon the hiring date. A mentor shall be assigned by the Superintendent to work directly with the beginning principal during the internship.

The beginning principal internship program shall be a county based program intended to provide appropriate orientation activities and supervision to beginning administrators.

Qualifications and duties of the mentor, along with specific information regarding the orientation program can be found in the Administrative Procedures Manual.
