

TYLER COUNTY POLICY: GBC

VOLUNTEERS – ADULT

The Tyler County Board of Education recognizes that adult volunteers play a vital role in the schools, and should be utilized to enhance students' educational experiences and to assist school personnel. Volunteers may be assigned by the building principal to work in various capacities, such as assisting with lunch supervision, clerical tasks, or working with individual students under the direction of the teacher. They are not authorized to administer formal testing to individual students or to access students' permanent records or teachers' grade books.

All principals are encouraged to implement an active volunteer program, and shall have the responsibility of screening and selecting applicants and making assignments. Volunteers must operate at all times under the direction of the principal.

Upon the recommendation of the principal through the Superintendent, the Board shall annually approve each school's list of adult volunteers. Each volunteer shall enter into a prescribed written agreement with the Board.
