

TYLER COUNTY POLICY: GBE

WEAPONS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

The Tyler County Board of Education recognizes its responsibility to provide a safe, secure teaching/learning environment. In an effort to protect students and staff to the maximum extent possible, the Board establishes the following policy:

Under no circumstances may any employee, student, or other person possess or carry or cause the possession or carrying of any firearm or other deadly or dangerous weapon on the premises of any Board-owned property, including school buses and vocational buildings, unless such person is a law-enforcement officer or he or she has the express written permission of the superintendent. Written permission may be granted only for a specific event.

Definitions of “deadly weapons” and specific exceptions are delineated in the West Virginia Code 61-7-2, 61-7-11a., and 61-7-14.
