

MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS

PHYSICAL EXAM

As a condition of employment, applicants for bus operator must pass a physical examination conducted by a certified doctor designated by the Tyler County Board of Education.

All regular and substitute bus operators shall also have an annual physical exam prior to the opening of each school year. These examinations shall be arranged by the Transportation Director and paid by the Board of Education.

TUBERCULIN TEST FOR SUPERINTENDENT

Before entering upon the discharge of his or her duties, the superintendent shall certify the following:

- a. An approved tuberculin skin test (PPD skin test) that reflects that the county Superintendent does not have tuberculosis in a communicable state four months prior to the beginning of a term, and
- b. Shall have an approved tuberculin skin test every two years, or more frequently if medically indicated.

A county superintendent who is certified by a licensed physician to have tuberculosis in a communicable state shall have his/her employment discontinued or suspended until the disease has been arrested and is no longer communicable.
