

## Tyler County Policy: IAG

### Credit Recovery

Credit recovery is an alternate to course repetition for students who have previously failed a course needed for high school graduation. Tyler County will be using the WV State's Virtual high school program for students who need to complete a requirement for graduation.

Upon the recommendation of the guidance office students who need to repeat a required class will be scheduled the next semester or year into a regular class for Credit Recovery. Credit Recovery can also be used as a summer school offering which will require the student to attend summer school on-site and complete the required on-line course. Each student will be charged Tuition for summer courses.

Courses will be offered during the school year and in the summer through WVVS. Tyler County will provide a trained facilitator for each class. The facilitator will monitor each student's work noting if they are completing assignments as needed and keeping in touch with the online teacher as to the quality of work being produced. All courses are self-paced and students can pursue an accelerated pathway to complete course requirements prior to the end of the semester or end of the summer term.

Grades will be given to each student by the on-line credit recovery teacher. The final grade will be transcribed upon course completion and will follow the grading scale established by the state and adopted by the Tyler County Board.
