

Report Cards

Report cards shall be completed for student's grades 1-12 on a six-week basis. Kindergarten students will receive formal reports cards during the months of December, March and June. Pre-K students will receive quarterly progress reports.

Report Cards for student's grades 1-12 shall be distributed one week following the end of the six-week grading period unless otherwise authorized by the superintendent.

Teachers in grades 1-12 electronically complete student report cards. Parents are notified in writing if students are having difficulty or are being considered for retention. (See County Policy IH)

Mid six weeks progress and /or deficiency reports shall be sent home with students grades K-8, and mailed to students grades 9-12 if the student is making failing grades or working below grade level.

The parents of all high school seniors shall be notified of the necessary credits needed for graduation by the building principal prior to the beginning of the school year.
