

TYLER COUNTY POLICY: II

GRADING SYSTEM/HONOR ROLL

Tyler County Schools will follow the uniform grading policy established by the West Virginia Board of Education for those courses for which high school credit is to be awarded.

	Percentage Points	Grades	*Quality Points
A = Excellent	90-100	A	4.0
B = Above Average	80-89	B	3.0
C = Average	70-79	C	2.0
D = Below Average	60-69	D	1.0
U = Unsatisfactory	59-0	U	0

*Used to determine Honor Roll and Class Ranking

Weighted grades shall be used for the following courses only:

- Any Dual Credit Course
- Any College Credit Course
- Any AP Course
- Any Honors Course
- Physics
- Biology II
- Chemistry II

Weighted Courses Grading Scale

Average	Grade	Quality Points
90-100	A	5.0
80-89	B	4.0
70-79	C	3.0
60-69	D	2.0
59-0	U	0

The actual percentage grade for each course will be placed on the report card.

For elementary schools, “S” for Satisfactory and “U” for Unsatisfactory will be used for science, social studies, and health, in grades 1-3, and for music and physical education in grades 1-5.

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A copy of each classroom teacher's grading procedures will be placed in the grade book and approved by the building principal annually.

Honor Roll: Any student earning a 3.2 or higher average in all subjects in grades 6-12 shall be listed on an honor roll for publication. Any student having an average grade of 74 or below in any one subject is automatically eliminated from the honor roll.

Determination of semester average and final grade: Each six-week grade shall have equal value in determining the average grade for the year. The sum of the six weeks percentage grades divided by total number of courses attempted shall be the final yearly average.

Semester averages at the high school shall be determined by the following method when semester exams are required: Each six week grade shall count as two-sevenths of the total semester grade average and the semester exam as one-seventh. The sum of these percentages divided by the number of courses attempted shall be the semester grade.
