

Comprehensive School Counseling Program

The Tyler County Board of Education has designated that developmental guidance programs be made available in all Early Learning Programs (Pre-K-Kindergarten), Early Learning Primary (1-2), Early Learning Intermediate (3-5), Middle Level Education (6-8), and Adolescent Education (9-12). Tyler County will ensure that the Comprehensive School Counseling Program is proactive and preventative, comprehensive in scope and developmental in nature. This program will enhance opportunities for every student to achieve school success through academic, career and personal and social development experience, as well as help prepare students to become globally responsible citizens.

The Comprehensive School Counseling Program (CSCP) will be standards based, and will utilize school and community data to identify student needs as well as set annual priorities.

Certified school counselors, in collaboration with school and community stakeholders will develop an Annual CSCP Plan in order to coordinate and implement programs that address student needs and contains personalized student planning, delivery of WV Student Success Standards, Responsive Services and Student Support.

Programs will be monitored by the principal to ensure that the plan was developed by the school counselor(s) and leadership teams and that the plan is aligned with the requirements set forth in State Board Policy 2315. (See Administrative Procedures Manual for Student Success Standards)
