

COMPULSORY HEARING, VISION, AND SPEECH/LANGUAGE TESTING

Annual sweep screening shall be conducted in the areas of hearing, vision, speech, and language. The annual screening shall, as a minimum sweep screen:

- A. All students entering school for the first time in West Virginia;
- B. Students entering kindergarten who did not participate in the pre-enrollment screening programs, within the first month of school;
- C. Individuals considered at high risk for potential problems in hearing, vision, speech and language;
- D. Students in at least one other grade level for potential hearing and vision problems;
- E. Refer directly for assessment those students identified through the sweep screening process.
