

SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Within the bounds of legal and ethical responsibilities to children, the Tyler County Board of Education has a right and responsibility to keep the public informed of significant happenings within the schools. It is the position of the Board that the public is entitled to be well-informed about the operations of the school system.

It is further the position of the Board that the school system will operate most successfully with the support of the community and that such support is dependent upon the maintenance of positive public opinion. It is important that information relating to school activities, methods, and objectives be conveyed to the public in order to maintain that positive public opinion.

It will be the policy of the Board to maintain a continuing program of internal employee relations and community relations through two-way communications.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for the development and implementation of a comprehensive, on-going program of school-community relations. The purpose of the program shall be to provide avenues for public input and for the Board to make known its plans and actions.

Every employee should promote good community relations for the schools and for the educational betterment of the students.
