

TYLER COUNTY POLICY: KD

COMMUNITY/ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Tyler County Board of Education believes that Community/Adult Education is a philosophy based on the principles of lifelong learning and citizens involvement in the schools. Thus, all Tyler County Schools, along with the Mid-Ohio Valley Technical Institute (MOVTI), shall become centers for life-long learning with partnerships that support teaching and learning.

Adult education programs shall address academic, vocational, recreational, and social needs. Annual community surveys will be utilized to determine the extent and variety of course offerings.

In accordance with West Virginia code 18-5-19b, the Board of Education may charge tuition for adult classes and/or programs, such tuition not to exceed the actual cost of operating such classes.
