

EDUCATION/AGENCY RELATIONS

The Tyler County Board of Education is committed to the formation of comprehensive community-based alliances for educational progress. It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent and his/her administrative staff to translate that commitment into a plan for interagency partnerships.

Schools and community agencies share overlapping responsibilities for children's development. As a result, schools must sustain a collaborative relationship with other community service agencies.

In order to make a maximum contribution to education, within the school system and to other educational agencies, the Board establishes these broad goals:

1. To encourage liaison with other educational and non-educational agencies;
2. To supply educational services to and/or share with other educational and non-educational agencies;
3. To provide the highest quality of educational programs for the total community and to support community projects; and
4. To cooperate with agencies concerned with the security, safety, health and well-being of the citizenry.
