Dear Parents and Guardians:

The *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001* (NCLB) requires all schools receiving Title I funds to inform parents they have a right to know about the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child and the aides and paraprofessionals who work in the classroom. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child's classroom teachers and requires our schools to give you this information in a timely manner if you ask for it.

Because Sistersville Elementary School and Arthur I. Boreman Elementary School each receive Title I funding, you have the right to ask for the following information about your child's classroom teachers and aides or paraprofessionals at any time throughout the year:

- Whether the West Virginia Department of Education has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subject he or she teaches;
- Whether the West Virginia Department of Education has decided that the teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances;
- Information about the teacher's college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and the subject of the advanced degrees;
- Whether any teachers' aides or similar paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.


In my dual role as the Director of Human Resources and the Title I Director, I can assure you that each of the teachers, and aides / paraprofessionals who work with your children at Sistersville and Arthur I. Boreman Elementary Schools are fully licensed and certified as a highly qualified teacher in at least one area of expertise, and are among the most qualified teachers and aides available. All have met the West Virginia Department of Education's high standards for teacher quality and professionalism.
