It is our goal to make sure every student has the opportunity to be successful. Who can make a referral? Making a referral can be done by teachers, parents, and even students. We are there to ensure our students excel and are willing to work with anyone who asks for help! To make a referral for a student who is in need:

1. Click on the Online Referral Attachment. These pages must be filled out completely. Save the document as "SIRS Referral - students initials" . Then e-mail document back to JHolmstrom@veccnj.org as an attachment.
2. Student will be discussed at the informal meeting in order to offer immediate suggestions. Then we will begin to gather data on the student. This includes a vision/ hearing screening, classroom observation, literacy bench marking, test score & cumulative folder review, discipline record check, attendance check, and interviews with teachers, parents, and students. Student will be placed on the monthly meeting schedule for interventions.
