LARRY BELL'S 12 POWERFUL WORDS: Predict.

Predict: Tell what you think will happen next. Use text clues to make your prediction.

It is important to understand that it's not about making something up out of the blue. It is about using pictures and/or text to guide our thoughts. Good readers make predictions every time they read. It starts to become second nature.

As you read practice this important strategy by asking these questions:

- 1. What do you think will happen next?
- 2. Why do you think that?
- 3. How do the pictures help us make that guess?
- 4. How does the text I just read help me make that guess?
- 5. I think this is going to happen because the text said this. (Modeling is a huge factor in helping students understand this strategy.)
