

2019 Scholarship

The Todd County Corn and Soybean Growers Association, an affiliate of the Minnesota Corn Growers Association would like to announce an Agriculture Scholarship Program. The association will award up to two \$1,000 scholarships to qualifying students who are pursuing a degree in agriculture. The program is sponsored by the National Corn Growers Association.

The application deadline for this year's award is April 1, 2019.

This scholarship can be used by college students at all levels—undergrads, graduates or students going back for a higher degree. The infrastructure of the agricultural community depends on continually attracting talented students into the field. We hope this scholarship heightens awareness of opportunities for education in agriculture. The award can go to any college expenses—tuition, books or living expenses.

Scholarship Description

- 1. Scholarships are for one year; previous winners may reapply and you are able to apply multiple times.
- 2. Scholarships may be used to offset tuition, school supplies, or student housing.
- 3. Scholarships awarded for 2018-2019 school year.
- 4. Funds will be issued directly to student after completion of first semester of first year of education.

Applicant/Application Requirements

- 1. Applicant must be a senior in high school or currently attending an accredited junior college, technical school, college or university.
- 2. Applicant must be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in an agricultural, agribusiness, or an ag vocation field.
- 3. Applicant must be an NCGA member or son/daughter of an NCGA member or willing to become a member.
- 4. Employees and the families of employees of any division NCGA are not eligible for the scholarship.
- 5. Applications must be postmarked March 31st, 2019.
- 6. Family of recipient must live or farm in Todd County.

- 2. Scholarship winner will be selected in early May and the winner will be notified.
