



Oregon's 2011-2012 School Report Card Ratings*

- 32% of schools (364 out of 1155) were rated Outstanding (last year 28%)
- 59% of schools (678 out of 1155) were rated Satisfactory (last year 64%)
- 10% of schools (113 out of 1155) were rated In Need of Improvement (last year 8%)
- 98 schools were not rated due to their small size or being open for less than two years

Elementary Schools:

- 34% of schools (235 out of 688) were rated Outstanding (last year 34%)
- 62% of schools (429 out of 688) were rated Satisfactory (last year 64%)
- 3% of schools (24 out of 688) were rated In Need of Improvement (last year less than 1%)
- 42 schools were not rated due to their small size or being open for less than two years

Middle Schools:

- 27% of schools (50 out of 183) were rated Outstanding (last year 16%)
- 71% of schools (130 out of 183) were rated Satisfactory (last year 82%)
- 2% of schools (3 out of 183) were rated In Need of Improvement (last year less than 1%)
- 8 schools were not rated due to their small size or being open for less than two years

High Schools:

- 28% of schools (79 out of 284) were rated Outstanding (last year 22%)
- 42% of schools (119 out of 284) were rated Satisfactory (last year 49%)
- 30% of schools (86 out of 284) were rated In Need of Improvement (last year 29%)
- 48 schools were not rated due to their small size or being open for less than two years
