# **ALUMNI SPORTS INITIATIVE**

Contributions to the Vernonia Alumni Sports Initiative continue to slowly accumulate. Thus far, 145 alumni have contributed over \$55,000 to this fund. In addition, another \$14,000 is available to use from the Gary Davis Memorial and the Class of 1973 "Give Back Bash" event. However, much more is needed for the development of athletic fields on the campus of the new Vernonia Schools.

The design work for the new fields has been completed, and now the process of moving dirt and planting grass actually begins! Thanks to a grant from the Oregon School Activities Association and matching funds from Evelyn Holce (Class of 42), the Vernonia Loggers will have a football practice field ready for this Fall.

Work on the new softball complex is underway, and our goal is to have this field ready and playable by March, 2015. In order for this to happen, more resources (in the form of cash contributions and volunteers) are badly needed now.
