PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

On Saturday, May 9 Vernonia School District will hold a celebratory event to officially recognize the Vernonia Schools building as an award winning project through the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) and The Green Building Initiative (GBI) for Environmental and Energy Efficiency rating systems.

Our new building continues to draw rave reviews from all new visitors, as well as our regular patrons. We are so pleased to be able to call it home! Besides the feel and look of the building, it is so nice to know that our efforts to build a school that is a model in functionality in terms of energy efficiency and design have been rewarded.

Our building has earned a "Platinum" designation (their highest level of recognition) through the LEED rating system, and "3 Green Globes" (their second highest level of recognition) through the GBI rating system. We hope you will be able to join us on this day to celebrate these major accomplishments.

Our Career and Technical Education programs continue to develop with Forestry/Natural Resources and Engineering wrapping up their work to become fully certified programs that are recognized by community colleges and 4-year universities. The new shop is almost complete, with finishing touches being made to the electrical and heating systems. Construction students have been working in the new shop to help with painting, tool set-up and installation of shelving units. Occupation is expected by mid -March.

One change the Vernonia Education Foundation's (VEF) board members recently issued is the assessment of a one-time foundation administrative fee of 5% charged on all new gifts. Each new donation or gift will be subject to the 5% fee to help offset costs incurred (mailings, secretarial support, etc.) by the Vernonia School District (VSD) through the VEF's fundraising efforts. Management fees are subject to change from time-to-time based on policies established by the VEF Board of Directors.
