PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE by Aaron Miller

Time flies when you are having fun and working hard, so it is no surprise that the Holiday season is upon us. In this time of giving and thanks we are so appreciative of all the support our alumni and partners continue to provide for the Vernonia School District (VSD) and the Vernonia Education Foundation (VEF). As partners we can truly make a difference.

This season will be a critical one for the VSD. The state legislature will meet in January and February and we continue to hope for some sort of relief from loans incurred at the end of our school construction project. Our overall debt is slowly decreasing and is now below the \$5 million mark, but the annual payments of over \$500,000 are becoming increasingly hard to make as the majority of these bills have been paid with dwindling cash raised through legislative actions and private donations to the VEF.

At last month's VEF Board meeting alum and longtime district supporters Evelyn Holce and Randy Holce made combined donations totaling over \$120,000 to provide funding for the Vernonia High School baseball field to be constructed on campus this spring. This type of generosity continues to bolster the district as we work to make ourselves whole at the new campus.

VERNONIA SCHOOLS HIGHLIGHTS By Aaron Miller & Matt Urban

Recovery efforts in the Vernonia School District and the community of Vernonia are being noticed outside of our town, with other schools wanting to participate and help in some of our natural resource/sustainability programs. In the fall of 2014, 8th grade students from the Jane Goodall Environmental Middle School in Salem, Oregon joined our Kindergarten, 4th grade and High School Forestry students during Salmon Watch activities learning about salmon life cycles, riparian zone health, water quality and actually observing salmon spawn in Rock Creek.

In the fall of 2015 8th graders from Lakeside School in Seattle, Washington made Vernonia the focus of their annual, week-long, community service field trip. These students also participated in Salmon Watch activities and performed community service at the local museum and wetlands; helped support reading and math instruction in the Kindergarten, Ist and 2nd grade classrooms at Vernonia Elementary School, and joined Vernonia Middle School 8th graders for several academic activities. Their students were so excited about the work they performed and the connections they made that Lakeside 8th graders will return to Vernonia in the Fall of 2016 for a similar experience.

The work we are doing in Vernonia Schools is making a dif-



ference. It is making a difference for our own students, in the lives of visiting students, and in our entire community. Thank you so much for being a part of it, and contributing to help us continue our journey forward!
