ALUMNI UPDATE By Ronda Lennen

The Vernonia High School Alumni Scholarship was established in 1976 by the class of 1936. Since that time approximately \$30,000 in scholarships have been granted to deserving Alumni or current High School Seniors. Contributions to the account have come from alumni, family and community members.

Records indicate the last sizable contribution was from the class of 1976 who turned over the remainder of their class treasury. This scholarship is supported solely through donations.

Beginning July 2016, the current Alumni Scholarship will be merging with the Vernonia Education Foundation. It is the hope of the current committee to continue to help support students interested in furthering their education. The program will award an annual amount of \$1,000 to be awarded to one recipient, or may be divided and distributed to multiple recipients.

Anyone can make a donation to the fund by sending a check, or cash payment, to the Vernonia Education Foundation/ Alumni Scholarship fund. Donations can be made anonymously, or can be made as memorials. If you are alumni making a donation, please specify your year of graduation. If you choose to make a memorial donation please specify the name (and year of graduation, if an Alum) of the person(s) in whose name(s) the donation is being made. Applications will be available at Vernonia High School.

The Vernonia High School (VHS) boys' basketball team won the 2016 OSAA State Basketball Championship held in Pendleton by beating Regis, 57-49. The team finished the season with a 16-0 league record and a 28-1 record overall. Several players earned All-Tournament and All-State honors while Coach David Weller was named the OSAA 2A Coach of the Year.

Vernonia Middle and High School students have had the opportunity to compete in two different FIRST Robotics leagues this year. While our students were not able to make the regional finals in either league, they did an outstanding job of fabricating a working "bot" and competing in each of the technical challenges set for each group. In addition, the FRC team was the recipient of a Daimler Trucks Robotics grant worth over \$18,000.

The VHS/Vernonia Hands On Art Annual Junior Salmon Auction will be coming up soon. VHS art students produce the artistic salmon replicas, and auction them off to earn money for the program.
