### 6.0 REPORTS & DISCUSSION

**Maintenance Report**: Tom Ramsey added to his report that over the 4<sup>th</sup> of July he discovered that the main transformer that feeds the high school stadium did not work. After the holiday he had WOEC come and look at it. Unfortunately the transformer is a total loss. Estimated cost to replace is \$6400 including labor.

Bill Langmaid asked if the transformer could be moved to the new school? Not likely – it will remain part of the stadium. There is one in ground transformer that feeds the green building that could be moved. There is also one in the parking lot by the Logger Dome and a couple others on poles that could be moved.

Ernie Smith: Asked about signage at the new Skate Park indicating skaters ride at their own risk and that the District is not liable. Dr. Cox indicated that it is a temp facility and that the Vernonia Prevention Coalition (VPC) is aware that the district can close the park if not run properly. Signs have been ordered.

7.4 Substitute Teacher Pay: Dr. Cox recommends that we keep the District teacher substitute pay at \$170.00 per day. This is approximately \$15 dollars higher than the state rate. Dr. Cox indicated he will monitor whether or not staff is calling for subs more frequently due to not having to contact their supervisor directly. Currently the district uses a call in system.

7.5 **Student Fees:** Some minor changes are being presented. New fees for next year would include:

2010-11 STUDENT FEES **DISCUSSED** 

- A \$15.00 student body fee at the Middle School. This will enable Middle School students to get into High School athletic events free of charge.
- An art fee of \$10.00 at the middle school and \$20.00 at the high school.
- A shop fee of \$30.00 at the high school.
- A \$20.00 per sport per child athletic Pay to Play fee at the middle school.
- The High School athletic Pay to Play fees have been increased to \$90.00 / \$75.00 /

There was discussion about creating a family maximum sports fee. Dr. Cox explained that after running the numbers and looking at the various family sizes within our district it would not be feasible to implement this.
