INTERIM PRINCIPAL / SPECIAL EDUCATION REPORT:

Superintendent Burrows presented the June 14, 2012 Interim Principal Report/Special Education Report in the absence of Dr. Elaine Lee. **Field Trips:** 8th graders went to Holiday Hills; 4th Graders went to EASTCONN's Lego program and 6th Graders went to RTI: 3rd and final benchmarks are completed; Scheduling Mystic Aquarium; Committee: developed the specials, band, chorus, and lunch scheduled for all grade levels; Writing Program: Language Arts Committee and Teachers reached a consensus that the 6+1 Traits Writing Program is an excellent program and should be reviewed for possible use in all grade levels. The Superintendent will review the program and present it to the Board of Education at a future date; Eighth Grade Banquet: The banquet was a big success; Honor Society: Amanda Hartman and Payton Marler were inducted into the Junior Honor Society; Field Day: Students enjoyed field day held June 6, 2012; Award Ceremony: The ceremony was held on June 14, 2012 and went very well; Club Night June 7, 2012: Music, art, poetry Teachers held a wonderful program and students sang, played instruments and recited poetry; DARE Graduation: held June 6th and students successfully reported on lessons learned; Special Education Issues: Paraprofessionals were evaluated this year using a pilot program based on the EASTCONN evaluation forms and the response from teachers and paraprofessionals was positive. The Virtual Learning Academy will be utilized by some students and allows for a productive learning environment using online courses
