regional professional development for the 2013-14 School year; School Garden looks great; Kindergarten registration is scheduled for May 14, and 15; Community/Public Relations: 9th Family Academy was held April 23rd and the topic was "Accessing Power School and Internet: 10th Family Academy will be held May 21st and the topic will be "Summer, Presenting Opportunities for Learning"; and the Talent Show held May 3rd was a wonderful evening.

SPECIAL EDUCATION REPORT

Dr. Elaine Lee presented the Special Education Report and highlighted information about: Enrollment Special Education: enrollment has increased by two students in the last month; there is also a new student in the seventh grade; Special Education High School: there are three students at Griswold; Special Education Out-Placed Students: there are eleven out-placed students; 504 Students: there are twenty-four students receiving 504 services. Projections: it is anticipated there will be nine out-placed students for the 2013-14 school year.

SUPERINTENDENT'S **REPORT**

Mr. Burrows reviewed his calendar of events for Jun & Jul 2013; Apr 11, 2013 Board Briefs and the enrollment report that noted, as of 5/1/13, there are 315 students (Pre-K through 8th Grade) plus 122 High School Students.
