PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Students as a Focal Point: Voluntown Elementary School (VES) had a very successful opening for the 2013-2014 school year; CMT data has been distributed to appropriate personnel - this data is being used at grade level meetings in order to meet the needs of all learners and to write SMART Goals for Teacher Evaluation systems; VES weekly notes are sent to all faculty members to inform them of what is happening in school for that week/month. Curriculum/Instruction/Assessment: completed and submitted the School Readiness Individual Report and Community Report to the Connecticut State Department of Education; we will be implementing the STAR Enterprise system that assesses math and reading; Teacher Evaluation materials were distributed and the new evaluation system was explained. Building/Grounds/Transportation: school administration. personnel, and students have successfully completed a practice fire drill: there was review of enhanced security upgrades as well as lockdown and evacuation procedures. Community/Public Relations: Principal Trakas attended the local farmers market on Sunday, August 25, 2013; welcomed new kindergarten and first grade families at a meetn-greet over the summer; sent a Scientific Research Based Intervention (SRBI) letter home to families explaining what this program is about and how school administration will continue to meet the needs of VES students; met with the PTO to coordinate upcoming events and assemblies; noted the first Family Night is planned for Tuesday, Sep 17, 2013, an open house is scheduled for Tue, Sep 24, and Wal-Mart chose VES as their "Teacher Rewards Program" recipient this year and presented our staff with twenty - \$50 gift cards

SPECIAL EDUCATION DIRECTOR REPORT

Dr. Elaine Lee presented the Special Education Report that highlighted information about: **Enrollment Special Education:** there will be (32) students receiving Special Education services in one or more subject areas in grades Pre-K through 8th grade; **Special Education High School:** 5 students will be receiving services (1 at NFA and 4 at Griswold High School); **Special Education Out-Placed Students:** 10 students will be outplaced; **504 Students:** (26) students are receiving 504 services; **Alternative 5th through 8th Grade Program:** this program continues to provide valuable services to both special education students and regular education students - (17) students will be receiving services in this program; **Evaluation:** special education teachers will complete more of the academic assessments in 2013-2014; **Medicaid Application:** we are currently waiting for the State to provide the three-party agreement form to begin applying for reimbursement for services such as OT, PT, and Speech and Counseling for students that qualify; **Paraprofessional Assignment:** paraprofessionals have been assigned actual case loads and support accommodations that do not require direct teacher services.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Mr. Burrows reviewed the following: Calendar of Events for Sep & Oct 2013; the enrollment report that noted, as of 9/4/13, there are 308 students (Pre-K through 8th Grade) plus 129 High School Students; Mr. Burrows is in receipt of the notice for Healthy Food Certification for the 2013-2014 school year; Mr. Burrows reviewed current status of REAP, IDEA, and Title I grants.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Tools for Schools: Mr. Burrows provided a summary report of the Connecticut State Department of Education School Facilities Survey for VES; Youth Services Bureau: scheduled to meet Wednesday, September 18, 2013. Curriculum Steering: scheduled to meet Wednesday, September 25, 2013. Transportation: next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, October 23, 2013; School/Community Safety Team: scheduled to meet this month to review security upgrades and plan for a fire drill and evacuation procedures; School Readiness Council: we have received a \$90,000 grant for 2013/2014; Teacher Evaluation Plan and Professional Development: this year we will implement a pilot program that meets the new state guidelines for Professional Learning and Teacher Evaluation; Community Conversations: Voluntown was awarded a \$1500 Grant. Mr. Burrows explained we will have a planning committee and schedule a special meeting in March 2014.

SOLAR PANEL PROJECT

The Board reviewed a proposal by ENCON. This topic was placed on the agenda for the next regular monthly meeting scheduled for Thursday, October 10, 2013.
