SPECIAL EDUCATION REPORT	Elaine Lee presented the Special Education Report and highlighted information about Enrollment : There are thirty (30) VES students receiving Special Education services. Two students in Pre-K-3; One student in PreK-4; Five students in 1 st grade; Three students in 2 nd grade; Two students in 3 rd grade; four students in 4 th grade; Eight students in 5 th grade; One student in 6 th grade; four students in 7 th grade; and one student in 8 th grade; PreK-3 program there are thirteen students; High School : There are four students in out-placed; 504 Students – there are (24) students receiving 504 services. Additionally, there was review of Enrollment Projections for 2013 – 2014;		
SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT	Mr. Burrows reviewed his calendar of events for Feb & Mar 2013. The enrollment report noted, as of 2/4/13, there are 319 students (Pre-K through 8 th Grade) plus 122 High School Students. Mr. Burrows distributed the NFA funded analysis of Voluntown Enrollment Projected by Grade to 2022.		
COMMITTEE REPORTS:	Youth Services Bureau - Diana Ingraham reported the YSB/LPC Advisory Board has been meeting on a regular basis. The search continues to interview for a part- tin Coordinator. This Advisory Board is currently reviewing ways to offer after schoprograms.		
	Tools for Schools Facility Use: Mr. Burrows noted the new bus depot parking lot is in use; Mr. Burrows is submitting a grant application for the possibility of expanding the school readiness classroom by removing a wall and changing existing storage space into classroom space; Mr. Burrows reviewed recent energy savings as a result of a recently completed CON-SERV project; Mr. Burrows continues to work with the Selectmen on the Five Year Facilities Maintenance Plan; review continues on installation of a new stairway to Constitution Field.		
	Strategic Plan: Mr. Burrows submitted a Draft of the Board of Education Goals for 2013-2014 as a 1 st reading.		
2013-2014 BUDGET	Mr. Burrows submitted the Proposed Initial 2013/2014 Budget for review. The proposal is \$6,415,620 and represents an increase of \$144,598 or 2.31% over the 2012/2013 budget of \$6,271,022. The goal is to again make every effort to develop a budget proposal with a sincere understanding of the cost impact to local property taxes. The ultimate goal is to meet the educational needs of students. The budget process seeks to have a cooperative approach between the Town and Board of Education to create a schedule that allows for community input and involvement.
