GUEST SPEAKER

Mr. Tom O'Connor, Food Services Director, was present to discuss the food services program for the 2013-2014 school year. There was discussion about ways to increase participation in the breakfast and lunch programs and the role the USDA plays regarding food prices, types of food offered and portion sizes. There were USDA changes in the menu this past year which resulted in an overall decline in participation throughout the region. Mr. O'Connor added he has significantly increased the number of commodity items overall from the USDA in 2013-2014.

Alycia Trakas presented the Principal's Report that highlighted information about:

**Students as a Focal Point:** updated the 2013-2014 Student / Parent Handbook, updated back to school materials for a smooth transition to the opening of school and distributed a

welcome letter to faculty and staff.

**Curriculum / Instruction/ Assessment**: attended Teacher Evaluation Training and Proficiency at EASTCONN; reviewed various committees in our school and the decision making format for the review, research, and development of curriculum, met with the school security consultant regarding security procedures in conjunction with the School/Community Safety Team

**Community / Public Relations**: planning has begun for a Voluntown Elementary School 5K run/walk in support of the Youth Services Bureau and a local Farmer's Market is planned for Sunday, August 25, 2013.

SPECIAL EDUCATION DIRECTOR REPORT Dr. Elaine Lee presented the Special Education Report that highlighted information about: **Enrollment Special Education:** There will be (36) students receiving Special Education services in one or more subject areas in grades Pre-K through 8<sup>th</sup> grade; **Special Education High School:** 3 students will be receiving services (1 at NFA and 2 at Griswold High School); **Special Education Out-Placed Students:** 9 students will be outplaced; **504 Students:** (25) students are receiving 504 services;

Alternative 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Program: this program continues to provide valuable services to both special education students and regular education students - (18) students will be receiving services in this program

**Evaluation:** Special education teachers will complete more of the assessment evaluations in 2013-2014.

Medicaid Application: the application for a National Provider Identifier number from the State has been completed. The Superintendent has requested that VES become a provider for the School Based Child Health Program.

Paraprofessional Assignment: paraprofessionals are being assigned case loads and will be responsible for all accommodations that do not require direct teacher services.

In 2012-2013, we used 98,404 less KWH than 2006-2007; the potential for future solar panel projects that may present additional reductions in electricity usage; Curriculum & Related Committee Reports 2013-2014; and the Voluntown Board of Education Chain of Command Organizational Chart 2013-2014.
