Section 1002.45 (5), Florida Statutes establishes student eligibility requirements for K-12 virtual instruction. A student may participate in virtual education in the school district in which he or she resides if:

*The student has spent the prior school year in attendance at a public school in this state and was enrolled and reported by a public school district for funding during the preceding October and February for purposes of the FEFP surveys.

*The student is a dependent child of a member of the US Armed Forces who was transferred within the last 12 months to this state from another state or from a foreign country pursuant to the parent's permanent change of state orders.

*The student was enrolled during the prior year in a school district virtual instruction program or a K-8 virtual school program approved by the state.
