Musical Instruments to make at home

Rainbow Rain Maker

Materials

1. Cardboard tube (Paper Towel Tube works great)
2. Duct tape or Contact paper
3. Beans or Rice
4. Colors and construction paper
5. Scissors
6. Glue stick

Instructions

1. Cover the tube with duct tape or contact paper
2. Fill the tube with dried beans or rice
3. Cover the ends with duct tape
4. Decorate like you want with colors and construction paper

Paper Plate Rainbow Tambourine

Materials

1. Gold Jingle Bells (can find these at Wal Mart or order from Amazon.)
2. Cotton Balls
3. Glue
4. Paper Plates
5. Markers or Colors
6. String (any color)
7. Hole punch

Instructions

1. Take the paper plate and fold in half
2. Color the paper plate to resemble a rainbow
3. Fill the folded plate with cotton balls
4. Glue the ends of the paper plate together and let sit until glue is dry.
5. Punch six holes all around the paper plate (see picture)

6. Take the bells and string and run through the holes and tie securely

Musical Maracas

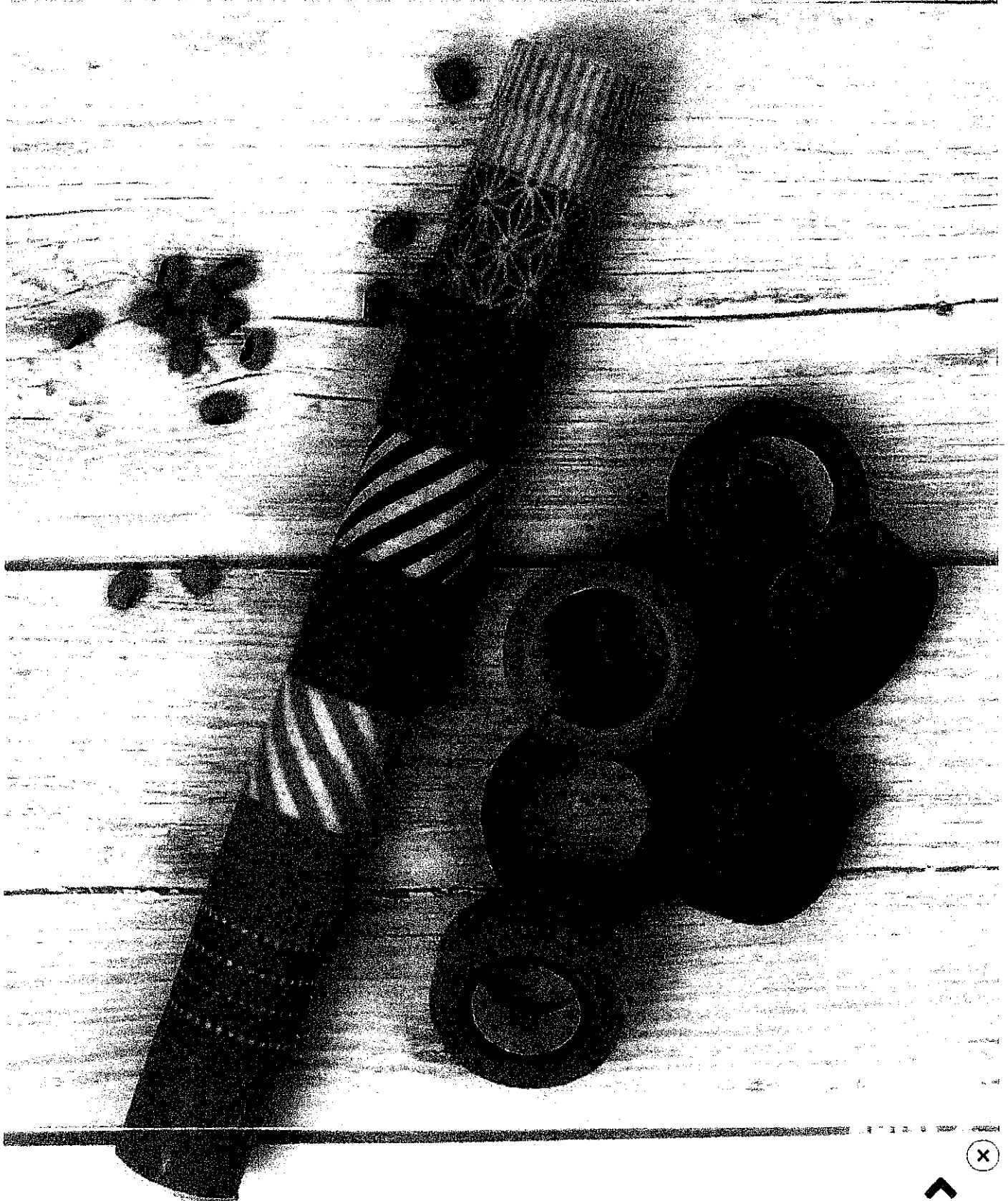
Materials

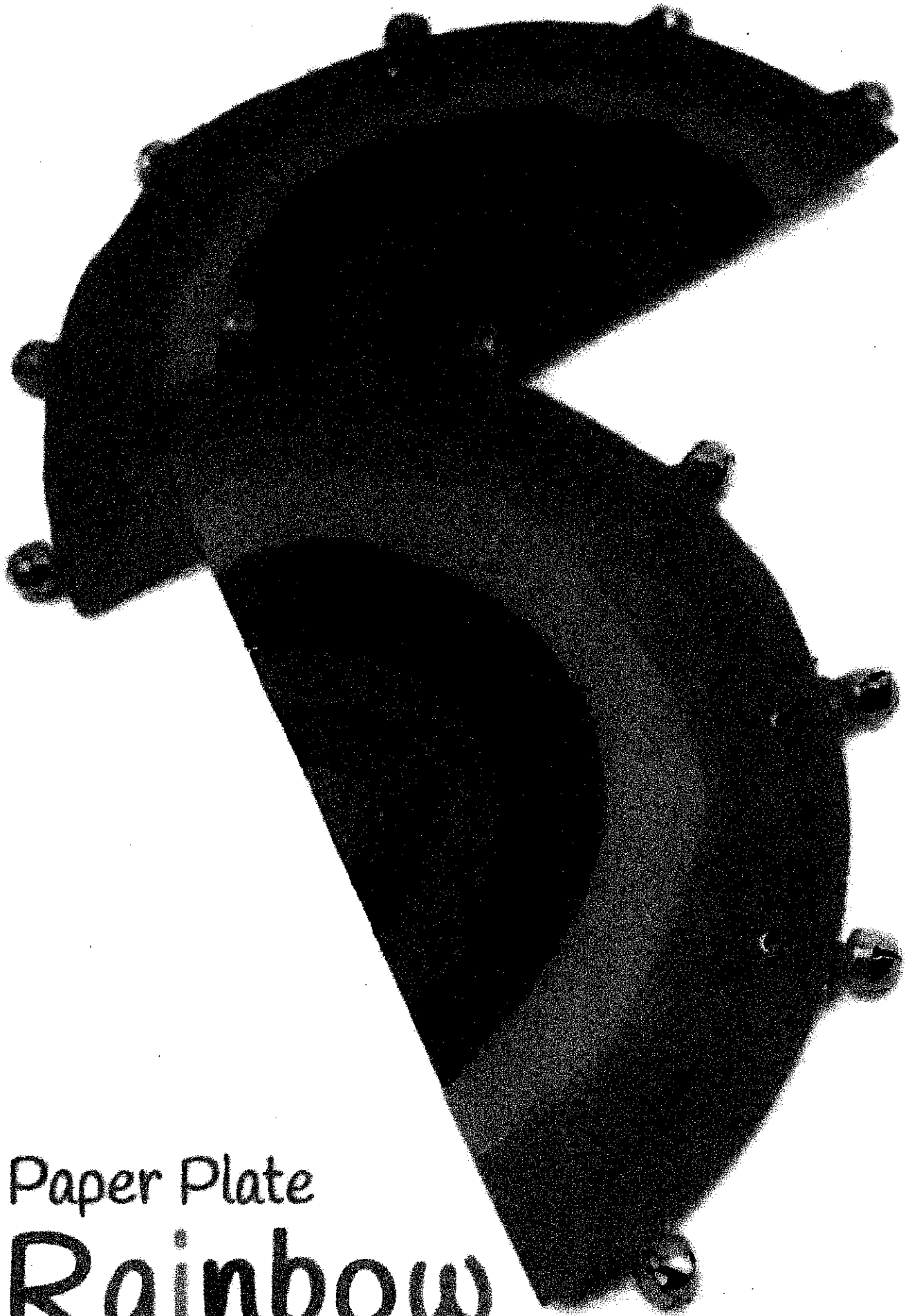
1. Plastic Easter Eggs
2. Plastic Spoons
3. Colorful duct tape
4. Dried beans
5. Colors and Markers

Instructions

1. Open the Easter eggs and fill with beans
2. Take the spoons and place on each side of the egg
3. Tape the spoons together
4. Decorate with colors or markers

MAKE YOUR OWN MARACAS

I'm always looking for fun activities to do with my toddler that are fun to create, and they serve a purpose once we're done. I decided it would be fun to make our own musical instruments – maracas to be exact.

Intermediate

STEP

Fill your plastic eggs with the dry ingredients. This is a great fine motor activity for little hands!

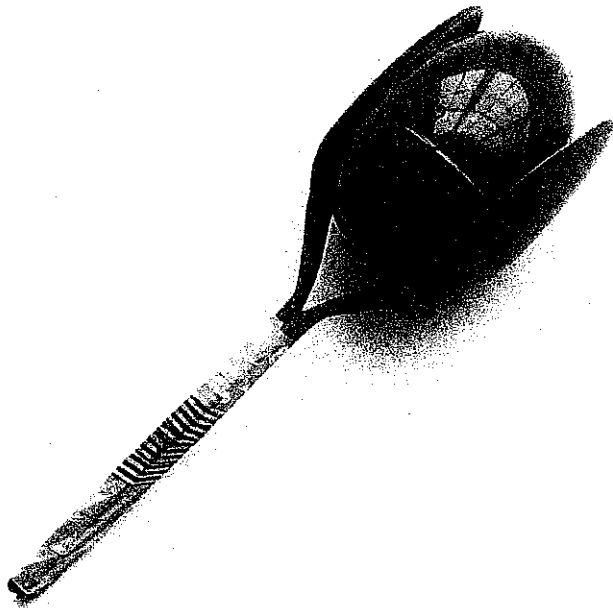
Feedback

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STEP

Put two spoons together, with the heads of the spoons facing. Grab your washi tape and begin wrapping it tightly around the handles of the spoons. Alternate with different washi tape patterns to make your maraca handles more colorful.



STEP

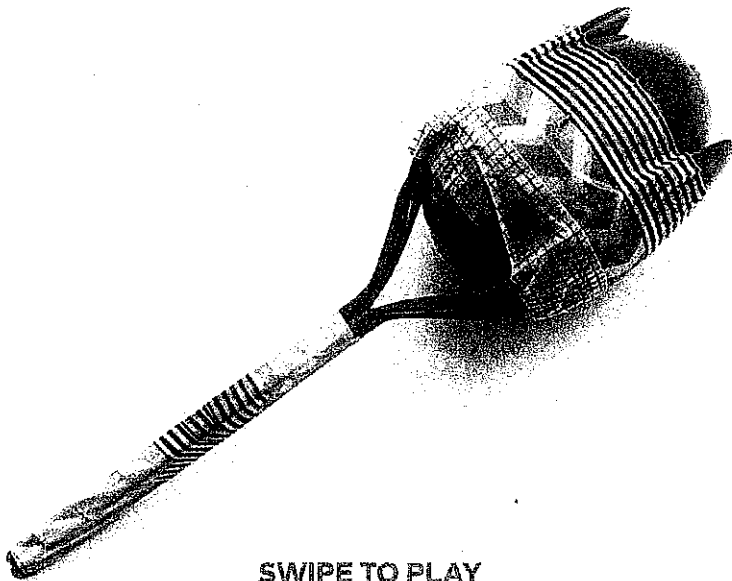
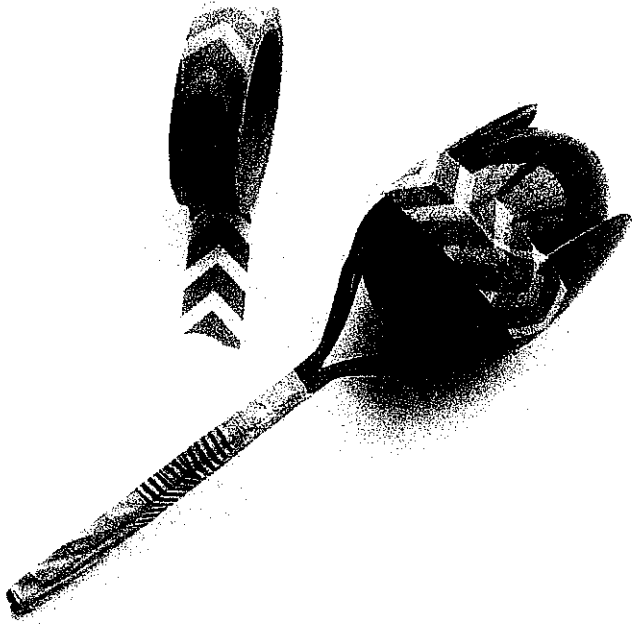
Open the heads of the spoons slightly and set an egg inside the heads of the spoon.

STEP

Wrap your egg with washi tape, beginning by going over the seam of the egg. Going around with the tape 2-3 times around the seam will make it more secure.
