Community Eligibility Provision

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We are pleased to inform you that beginning October 1, 2017 *Wellsville Local School District* will be implementing an option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) beginning October 1, 2017 for the rest of the School Year 2017-2018.

What does this mean for you and your children attending the school district?

All enrolled students of Wellsville Local School District will be eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household beginning October 1, 2017 of the 2017-2018 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without paying a fee and without submitting an application.

No applications are necessary!

This includes all students at Garfield Elementary, Daw Elementary/Middle School, and now Wellsville High School!
