Dear Parent,

As to comply with the new provisions of the Parents' Right To Know put forth by the U.S. Department of Education, school districts must provide parents with the right to know about the quality of their children's teachers.

The law clearly states that at the beginning of each school year, districts must notify all parents, of children attending Title I schools, that they can request information regarding their children's classroom teachers, and any other professional staff providing educational services to their children.

This includes, at a minimum, information on (1) completion of state requirements for licensure and certification; (2) emergency or other provisional status; (3) educational background; and (4) whether paraprofessionals are serving the child and, if so, the paraprofessionals' qualifications.

At this time the district can attest that all Title I staff and classroom teachers instructing the district's students hold appropriate state certifications.
