Dear Wyoming Area Cyber students:

Please be advised the Wyoming Area School District has continued to collaborate with each other, other school districts, and Educational attorneys as well as our VLN partners regarding the reopening of the Cyber platform.

As of last evening, April 6, 2020; the administration has decided to allow students to continue working on their Mods. However, and very important to understand – if a student moves on to any NEW (4<sup>th</sup> Marking Period) Mod, there will NOT be any teacher feedback or guidance or assistance and the Mod(s) will NOT be graded. This includes the following:

**Full Year Courses: MODs #28 - #36**

**Spring Courses: MODs #10 - #18**

We need to remain in compliance with our Continuity of Education (CoE) Plan (posted on the district's website) which dictates that Teachers and Students may only engage in Enrichment and Review activities at this point in time in accordance with our Phase I and Phase II Continuity plan which is posted to our district website (<http://www.wyomingarea.org/>). In addition to the Mod/grading restrictions noted above, this impacts virtual classrooms and teacher supports as follows:

- Wyoming Area Cyber daily homeroom will not be held.
- Teachers may not assist students in Office Hours and Resource Room, or via Homework Helpline or tutor requests.

We are not permitting Wyoming Area Cyber students to engage in Google Classroom Enrichment and Review activities because this may be difficult for these students since they have not been in the traditional brick and mortar setting, which could lead to exposure to new content and skills for our cyber students that is not permitted at this point in time during Phase I and II of the CoE plan.

Furthermore, since *schools are closed indefinitely*; we encourage you to visit our district website. This website department is dedicated to STUDENT RESOURCES and ENRICHMENT. After clicking on STUDENT RESOURCES at the top left under the district seal; Click on any of the SUBJECTS listed to the left to access lists and links of supplemental websites for elementary and secondary level students.
