New PA Department of Health Guidelines Regarding Covid-19

Positive Test Results:

- For all positive test results- regardless of vaccination status:
 - The onset of symptoms, or the day of the positive test is DAY ZERO.
 - Isolate for 5 days after DAY ZERO.
 - Return to work or school if no symptoms or symptoms are resolving.
 - -Resolving symptoms means you are fever free for 24 hours with no excessive coughing, sneezing or running of the nose.
 - If you have any of these symptoms after 5 days of isolation you MUST CONTINUE to quarantine for 5 ADDITIONAL DAYS.

Household Contacts of Positive Results:

- If someone in your household tests positive, you must follow these guidelines:
 - If you are Vaccinated and Boosted:
 - No need to quarantine.
 - Wear a mask for 15 days.
 - Recommend testing on day 5 and day 10.

– Vaccinated NOT Boosted and for those Unvaccinated:

- You MUST quarantine:
 - o 5 day isolation (with the positive household member), and 5 day quarantine.
- If you become symptomatic at any time, you must guarantine and test.
 - Positive- follow positive guidelines.
 - Negative return to household contact guidelines.

Close Contacts:

- A close contact is anyone who was near a positive person unmasked, closer than 3 feet, unmasked for 15 minutes within 48 hours of the onset of symptoms or a positive test result. (Day of Exposure is Day Zero)
 - Close Contact Quarantine/Testing Requirements:
 - Vaccinated and Boosted
 - No quarantine unless symptoms present.
 - Wear a mask for 10 days.
 - Recommended to test after day 5 of exposure.

- Vaccinated and NOT Boosted

- Quarantine for 5 days.
- Recommended to test after day 5 of exposure.
- · Wear a mask for 5 additional days.

- Unvaccinated

- Quarantine for 5 days
- Recommended to test after day 5 of exposure.
- Wear a mask for 5 additional days.
