New PA Department of Health Guidelines Regarding Covid-19

Positive Test Results:

- For all positive test results- regardless of vaccination status:
 - The onset of symptoms, or the day of the positive test is **DAY ZERO**.
 - Isolate for 5 days after **DAY ZERO**.
 - Return to work or school if no symptoms or symptoms are resolving.
 - **Resolving symptoms means you are fever free for 24 hours with no excessive coughing, sneezing or running of the nose.**
 - If you have any of these symptoms after 5 days of isolation you **MUST CONTINUE** to quarantine for **5 ADDITIONAL DAYS**.

Household Contacts of Positive Results:

- If someone in your household tests positive, you must follow these guidelines:
 - **If you are Vaccinated and Boosted:**
 - No need to quarantine.
 - Wear a mask for 15 days.
 - Recommend testing on day 5 and day 10.
 - **Vaccinated NOT Boosted and for those Unvaccinated:**
 - You **MUST** quarantine:
 - 5 day isolation (with the positive household member), and 5 day quarantine.
 - If you become symptomatic at any time, you must quarantine and test.
 - Positive- follow positive guidelines.
 - Negative - return to household contact guidelines.

Close Contacts:

– A close contact is anyone who was near a positive person unmasked, closer than 3 feet, unmasked for 15 minutes within 48 hours of the onset of symptoms or a positive test result . (Day of Exposure is Day Zero)

- **Close Contact Quarantine/Testing Requirements:**
 - **Vaccinated and Boosted**
 - No quarantine unless symptoms present.
 - Wear a mask for 10 days.
 - Recommended to test after day 5 of exposure.
 - **Vaccinated and NOT Boosted**
 - Quarantine for 5 days.
 - Recommended to test after day 5 of exposure.
 - Wear a mask for 5 additional days.
 - **Unvaccinated**
 - Quarantine for 5 days
 - Recommended to test after day 5 of exposure.
 - Wear a mask for 5 additional days.
