Dear Parents/Guardians,

This message is to provide information to parents/guardians and to highlight parts of the dress code policy.

With the changing of the season and the weather becoming colder, the administration wanted to remind both students and parents/guardians of what can be worn to school.

Listed below are the some of the prohibited dress code items:

- Hooded attire of any kind
- Large graphics or logos on t-shirts (short- or long sleeve)
- Sweat Pants
- Cargo pants or shorts
- Yoga, Stretch, or spandex pants or leggings can only be worn under a length appropriate dress or skirt. **(All dresses and skirts must extend to the top of the knee)**
- Flip-flops, slides and shoes without backs are not permitted
- Any camouflage attire
- Torn, ripped, or frayed clothing
- Clothing deemed offensive, sexually suggestive, condoning violence, drug/alcohol/tobacco use, suicide or vulgar language is not permitted.

Students who are in violation of the dress code policy will be asked to change or, if that is not possible, parents/guardians will be called to bring a change of clothing.
