Ms. Gold made a motion, with a second by Ms. Hunter, to approve the 2015-2016 SY budget (attached). Prior to the vote, Ms. Cathey, Ms. Hunter, Mr. Jones, Mr. Moses, and Mr. Perryman read a disclosure statement. The motion passed 9-0.

Ms. Hunter made a motion, with a second by Ms. Gold, to approve the 2015-2016 food service budget (attached). The motion passed 9-0.

During discussions concerning the cameras for Westhills Elementary School, Ms. Abernathy said the quote (attached) is off the state bid and is the same vendor who installed cameras at MCHS and LMS.
