The Executive Committee of the Marshall County Board of Education, comprised of Chairman of the Board Donnie Moses and Director of Schools Jackie Abernathy, spoke by phone Thursday, March 26, 2015, at approximately 12:50 p.m. to discuss excusing the two snow days declared state of emergency days by the governor.

Prior to the executive session, Director Abernathy collected information from other school systems, then spoke with seven of the nine board members (unable to contact two) about the information she had reviewed.

The Executive Committee voted 2-0 to approve excusing support personnel (teachers are covered by stockpiled days) from using vacation/personal days for the two days the governor declared as a state of emergency.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 1:00 p.m.
