II. PROCEDURES

K-8 schools in Marshall County will use the Tennessee State Board of Education's Unified Grading Policy to determine numerical/letter grades. Grades K-1 are an exception to this procedure in that they may use a Standards Based Report Card. Students are assessed on state grade level standards for kindergarten and first grade. The following legend will be used on the report card:

X = Mastered

/ = Partially Mastered

O = Not Mastered

⊗ = Re-Taught and Mastered

Grades will be reported to parents on the following timeline for each semester:

Semester 1:

4 ½ week progress report

9 week report card (Q1)

13 ½ week progress report

18 week report card (Q2)

Semester 2:

4 ½ week progress report

9 week report card (Q3)

13 ½ week progress report

18 week report card (Q4)

Quarter 1 and Quarter 2 grades will be averaged to determine the semester 1 grade. Quarter 3 and Quarter 4 grades will be averaged together with the TN Ready Assessment counting 15% of the semester 2 grade. Semester 1 and Semester 2 will be averaged for a Final Course Grade.

Q1 (50%) + Q2 (50%) = S1

Q3 (42.5%) + Q4 (42.5%) + TNReady (15%) = S2

S1 (50%) + S2 (50%) = FG (Final Grade)
