Subject: Opioid Antagonist

I. DEFINITIONS

Opioid: Opioids are a class of drugs that include the illegal drug heroin, synthetic opioids such as fentanyl, and pain relievers available legally by prescription, such as oxycodone (OxyContin®), hydrocodone (Vicodin®), codeine, morphine, and many others.

Antagonist: An *antagonist* is a drug that blocks opioids by attaching to the opioid receptors without activating them. Antagonists cause no opioid effect and block full agonist opioids. Examples are naltrexone and naloxone.

II. PROCEDURES

The Narcan Administration Protocol shall be followed at all schools.

Narcan is kept in the AED cabinet, which shall remain unlocked.

School nurses shall report usage to the Central Office and document as per protocol.

Annual training updates shall be provided to nurses and staff responsible to Narcan administration.
