**I. DEFINITIONS**

**Anaphylaxis** – a severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reaction

**II. PROCEDURES**

The Food Allergy and Anaphylaxis Emergency Care Plan will be followed for all students with severe food allergies. The plan shall be updated annually and signed by a physician or physician extender.

The parent/guardian will be required to fill out a new Student Health History annually at the beginning of the school year. The Student Health History shall be immediately reviewed by the school nurse. Copies shall be given to the Principal, office staff, teachers, coaches, and cafeteria staff. An Allergy Folder shall be made for the cafeteria annually, including a current picture, student name, teacher, and allergen.
