Subject: Supplement to Graduation Requirements

I. RATIONALE:

In order to improve the overall graduation rate of all Marshall County high schools.

II. PROCEDURES

Procedures for students who are 18 years of age:

A student who reaches his/her 18th birthday and has accumulated the third unexcused absence during the school year will be required to meet, accompanied by a parent, with a school administrator and a county social worker. The parent and the student will be informed that if the student reaches a total of five (5) unexcused absences, all extracurricular activities will be lost for the remainder of the school year.

This would include, but not be limited to sports, band, clubs, prom, senior trip, and all graduation activities.

All parties in attendance would be required to sign a statement that they understand the consequences of reaching five unexcused absences.
