Prayer/Pledge

Ms. Hunter made a motion, with a second by Ms. Gold, to approve the agenda. The motion passed 8-0.

Mr. Sorrells recognized Donna Poarch as the Marshall County High School Classified Employee of the Month.

There was no MCEA report.

K-6 Curriculum Coordinator Tammy Lewis presented a K-4 reading program update.

Ms. Hunter made a motion, with a second by Mr. Dippold, to approve the minutes of the December 12, 2016, regular session. The motion passed 8-0.

Ms. Hunter scheduled a Policy Committee meeting for Monday, February 13, 2017, at 5:30 p.m., prior to the regular monthly board meeting at 6:00 p.m.

In discussing the Forrest High School graduation date/time, the rules were suspended to allow FHS principal Davy McClaran to address the board. Mr. Jones made a motion, with a second by Ms. Cathey, to move the graduation date back to Saturday, May 20, 2017. Following discussions, the motion passed 7-1, with Mr. Warf voting no.
