

- · Bring the certificate or your high school transcript to one of the colleges listed or to ANY community or technical collage in Alabama for a course that has a statewide articulation agreement and enroll in a career program or major. For a list of courses that articulate statewide, visit the Tech Prep website at www.altechprep.org.

You need to check with the college of your choice for specific criteria in a program or major — not all credits will move into all programs or majors.

Additional colleges may accept these credits depending on their criteria and program offerings.

What is Tech Prep?

Tech Prep is short for Technical Preparation.

Tech Prep is a way to start a college technical major in high school. In a Tech Prep program, students begin their course of study in high school and continue in college or an apprenticeship program. In Alabama there are 20 Tech Prep Consortium that include 125 School Systems and 21 postsecondary institutions.



Exploring opportunities through Tech Prep means you can...

- Earn Technical or Community College credits (Tech Prep College Credit) in 10,11, and 12th grades
- · Stay in your own high school with your friends and the teachers you already know
- · Explore career opportunities through high school courses
- · Complete your college program sooner, save time and money
- · Choose a specific technical or Community College career program or major that may transfer to a university
