Onomatopoeia: a sound device where the words sound like their meaning, or mimic sounds	1) The sheep went, "Baa." 2) The sack fell into the river with a splash!
Simile: compares two unlike things using like or as	1) My choir teacher sings like an angel. 2) I am as busy as a bee.
Metaphor: compares two unlike things <u>without</u> using like or as.	1) He is a shining star. 2) That lawn is a green carpet
