Date: August 4, 2020

Overview: We continue to have a strong and close working partnership with our transportation provider All-Star Transportation. All-Star has a thorough plan in place to comply with CDC guidelines on cleaning products and the frequency of sanitizing school buses.

District-wide Information for All Schools:

- Whether the district is operating in Tier 1 (all students in school each day) or Tier 2 (50% of students attend per day), school bus stops and routes will remain relatively unchanged.
- School buses will be thoroughly disinfected each afternoon.
- Common touch points will be disinfected between bus runs.
- All students and adults are required to wear a face covering while on the bus unless a special exception has been approved by the school principal.
- Where possible, schools will add additional drop-off points at school to spread out the foot traffic as students enter school and at dismissal.
- Drop-off and pick-up will be spread across more time to lessen congestion in school hallways.
- Students will be asked to load the bus from back to front. Students who are the first ones on the bus will occupy the rear seats and fill the bus toward the front as more students are picked up. This will minimize students passing each other.

Specific Information for Tyrrell School:

- In an effort to facilitate appropriate distancing, students being transported by bus will be allowed to enter and exit the building at one of three entrances/exits. Locations will be the main entrance, the sixth grade hallway entrance (near room 104, but also located at the front of the building), and small busses will utilize the faculty entrance near the generator in front of the baseball field.
- Students are required to remain seated in the same seat and may not change seats at any time of transport to or from school?
